



Fall Protection – Warning Line Systems

This is a barrier erected to alert workers who are approaching an unprotected roof side or edge of a low-sloped roof. Warning lines can only be used in conjunction with another system such as a guardrail or safety monitor.

This designates the area where work can be performed without guardrails, body harnesses or safety nets.

A warning line can be made of rope, wire, or chain, and must be 34 to 39 inches above the working surface. It must also be marked every 6 feet with a highly visible material such as caution tape, or red or orange pennants.
