

ICCI Leads in Safety Training

ICCI Background

Independent Commercial Contractors, Inc. has been in the building demolition business for 10 years. They often are asked to bid based on past experience with their customers. They require detailed formal safety training of their employees. This training includes HazWoper and OSHA mandated training.

Barbara DeYear, President of ICCI, knows the value of safety training. It is a big part of their daily work operations. This is no doubt the reason they have had very few accidents over their years in business.

Actions Taken

As Licensed Asbestos and Lead Abatement Contractors, training and refresher training are part of the licensing process. This training is also part of the license renewal process. Training is complete only when the certificate is filed on the company safety file.

Outcomes

Site Supervisors are required to plan and monitor safety at the worksite. Part of their safety planning is having the testing and monitoring controls in place. This is a regular part of the work environment.

Protective equipment is provided and used for these projects. This equipment is inspected daily and deficient equipment replaced immediately. This includes hard hats, safety glasses, face shields, gloves, respirators, and other specialized protective equipment.

Updates

Safety regulations are updated often. ICCI gets these updates and provides additional training as needed. This is one of their standard operating procedures.

The project owners and construction managers also have procedures and policies that are updated on a regular basis. ICCI takes these changes as part of the bid specification and has them incorporated into their bid. This is one of several reasons why they are invited to so many bids. Building and plant owners know their reputation for quality work that is safely done.
